RACING FORMAT

Racing will start at 9.30am both days.

The race order will be:

1, Juniors Specials, 2, 3, 5, Junior F600, 7, 9, Junior Saloons, 4, F600, 6, Stockhatch, 8, 10.

Each driver will race three heats consisting of four and three quarter laps. Points from all three heats will be added together to determine who the top eight point scorers are. The top eight point scorers qualify for the class final. In the event of a tie in points scored, a run off will occur between the said drivers. Once the top eight point scorers have been determined they will participate in the final which consists of seven and three quarter laps.

Following each final, all eight finalists will be invited to take part in a parade lap of the track.

The winner of each class will then be entered into a staggered start, Champion of Champions race.

Following the conclusion of all the finals and the Champion of Champions race there will be an awards ceremony.






We are proud to announce that this year, we will continue to support the Air Ambulance and The Shakespeare Hospice as our chosen charities.

SITE PLAN AND INFORMATION



TO HELP US TO HELP YOU HAVE AN ENJOYABLE AND SAFE WEEKEND, THERE ARE A FEW RULES THAT WE EXPECT EVERYONE TO ABIDE BY.

- No open fires.
- Keep the emergency access road clear at all times.
- Camp as instructed with a minimum of three meters

Tricky question to answer... I have a certain way of getting all my race gear on, focus, be calm & switch off from everything.




